Registration Guidelines

Eligibility Criteria

- Age Requirement: Participants must be between 10 and 19 years old.
- Business Idea: Participants should have a business idea or project that aligns with one or more of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals.
- **Team Composition:** Teams must consist of 5 members. Each member must meet the age requirement for the age category the team is applying for.
 - Juniors: 10 to 15 years old
 - Seniors: 16 to 19 years old)
- Only registration as a group is accepted.

Participation

Q1. Who may participate in L.E.A.D Convention?

L.E.A.D Convention is open to youth aged 10 to 19 years old from around ASEAN who have an entrepreneurial idea on how to solve issues within their countries and associated with the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals, but do not have the platform or resources to do so. Do note that the convention will be conducted in **English**.

Q2. Can I sign up for more than one United Nations' 17 SDGs?

Yes, participants can focus on one or more of the United Nations' 17 Sustainable Development Goals with their projects, but they must specify which SDGs they are addressing when they register.

Q3. Must I already have a team in order to join L.E.A.D Convention?

Yes, participants must already have team of 5 (including the participant) to register for L.E.A.D Convention.

Q4. What if my team members are of different ages? Can we apply for the age category that majority of my team members are in?

L.E.A.D Convention has 2 separate age categories: **Juniors (10 to 15 years old)** and **Seniors (16 to 19 years old)**. Unfortunately, due to a number of considerations including different judging panels, **ALL** team members must belong to the same age category during the convention year to be eligible to apply as either Juniors or Seniors.



Programme

Q5. What can I look forward to in L.E.A.D Convention?

Participants can look forward to a series of enriching events at the L.E.A.D Convention. The journey begins with Grow Inc., an online platform created by Temasek Polytechnic Incubatee, SD Trainers, which prepares participants for the convention one month in advance.

During the convention, attendees can engage in L.E.A.D Workshops led by experienced trainers and professionals, each designed to address different aspects of what L.E.A.D stands for. Participants will also have the chance to network with peers from various countries, fostering cross-cultural exchanges, as well as connect with potential sponsors and mentors.

Additionally, participants will set up business displays to showcase their ideas to sponsors and investors before presenting to a judging panel. The top three winners in each age category will receive seed funding of up to USD \$4,000 to help grow their businesses.

Q6. Will my team and I need to participate in all 3 days?

Yes, participants are required to participate fully in all 3 days of the convention. Each session has been carefully designed to maximise the learning of participants and value-add to their experience in only 3 days.

Q7. What should participants bring to the convention?

Participants are recommended to bring necessary items for their presentations to best display their business project. This could be in the form of display items or materials created to showcase their project.

Q8. Is there a dress code?

While there is no specific attire for the L.E.A.D. Convention, we encourage participants to dress appropriately as delegates representing their respective countries. This means considering the professional nature of the event, where you will attend workshops led by trainers, network with peers and potential sponsors, and present your projects to professionals and entrepreneurs. However, do wear pants or jeans and ensure that your attire has no offensive graphics or texts.

Q9. I would like to know more about the seed money.

Seed money will be awarded to the top three winners in each age category (Junior and Senior), with the amount depending on their final placement. Winners will receive mentorship to help grow their business ideas, and the seed money will be disbursed in installments upon achieving specific milestones. This approach ensures that L.E.A.D. Convention winners continue to reach new heights.





Accommodation & Transport

Q10. Who is responsible for booking accommodation and transport?

Participants are responsible for their own accommodation and transportation to and from the L.E.A.D. Convention.

For those coming from overseas, please consult your respective Country Manager for assistance. Otherwise, you can contact us directly at lead@one-project.org, and we can help facilitate accommodation and transport arrangements with our partners.

While O.N.E. Project can provide options for accommodations at various star ratings and at various price points, participants will be responsible for their chosen lodging based on their preferences and budget.

Q11. Are there recommended transportation options to the venue?

Singapore has a growing and accessible transportation system. Participants can utilize public transport, including buses and Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) trains, to navigate the city easily.

Alternatively, participants can book private hire vehicles through apps like GRAB for more convenience.

Q12. What is the process for booking accommodations through the convention?

If you are in contact with a Country Manager, please liaise with them. Otherwise, please feel free to drop us an email.





Q13. Will meals be provided?

Lunch and one networking breakfast will be provided for participants over the three days of the L.E.A.D. Convention. Please be sure to indicate your dietary preferences and any food allergies, along with their severity, on your registration form.

Q14. I have a specific diet that I need to adhere to.

We try to accommodate our participants as much as possible with regards to religious or medical dietary requirements but specific diets will need to be further discussed.

Q15. What if I have allergies?

At L.E.A.D Convention, we will cater meals based on the dietary preferences and allergies indicated in your registration. However, please note that we are not responsible for any food consumed that has not been provided or listed as an allergy during registration. If snacks are provided, we will clearly indicate common allergens, such as nuts, but it is ultimately the responsibility of participants to consume these items consciously.

Q16. Is there a meal plan for participants staying at accommodations?

There is no specific meal plan for participants staying at the accommodation. We will only provide the meals listed in the event itinerary, which includes lunch and one networking breakfast during the convention. Participants are encouraged to explore local dining options for additional meals.
